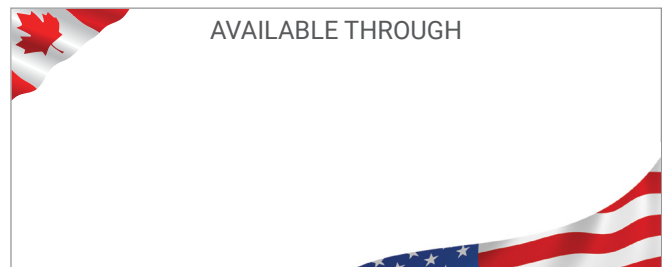

b. Retired Personnel defined as A) enlisted personnel or officers with a minimum of 20 years of service, B) medically retired, or C) 100% disabled:

i - U.S. Military: DD214, WD AGO (War Department Adjunct General Form) or NAVPERS (Naval Personnel Discharge Form)

ii - Canadian National Defense: CF1FC All Service Silver Card with the word Veteran in the lower left corner PMD19FP15602 certificate of discharge.

c. Veterans with an Honorable Discharge serving a minimum of two years or six months in an active war zone:

i - U.S. Military: DD214⁴, WD AGO (War Department Adjunct General Form) or NAVPERS (Naval Personnel Discharge Form)

ii - Canadian National Defense: Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC) Health Identification Card
